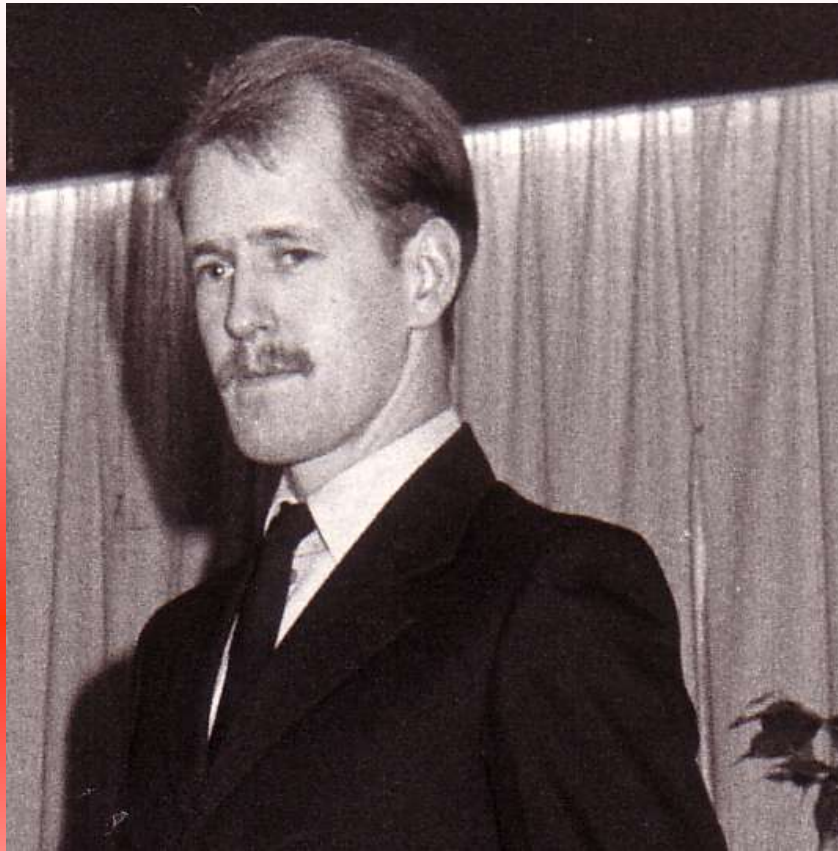

- Take no risk to attempt to save life or property that is already lost



















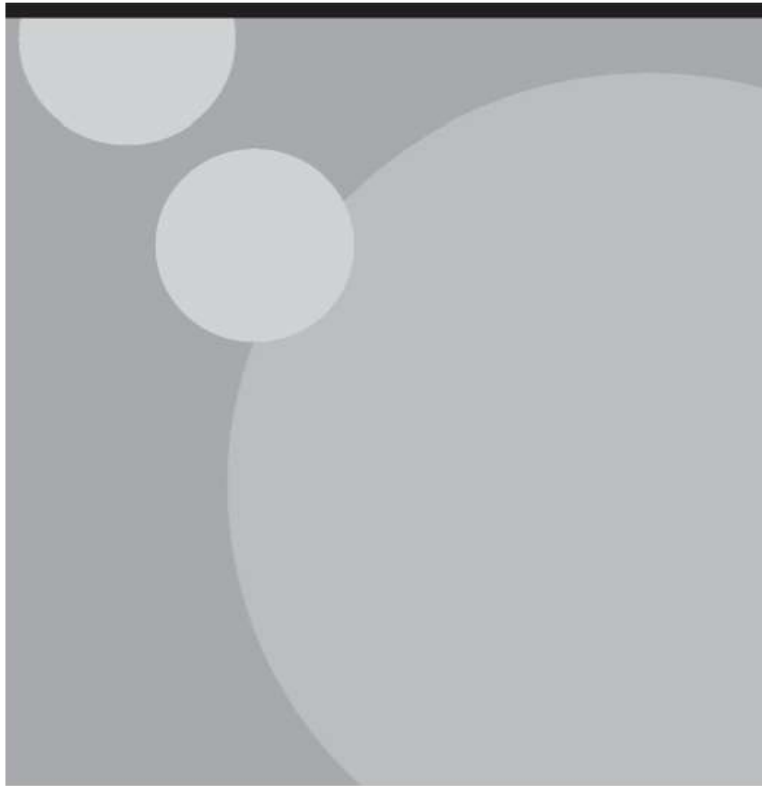

Summary of responses

“The case for a renewed FoSI reporting system is not clear. The new arrangements cover both rapid, and detailed reporting of incidents: rapid reporting is covered as FRSs should report incidents of significance to the Chief Fire and Rescue Advisor Duty Officer, and detailed analysis is possible via the IRS – this captures details of fires in much more detail than a parallel system could”.
